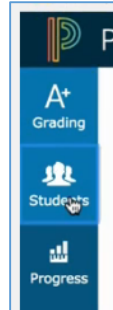


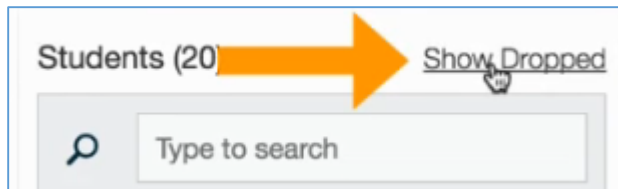
Report Card for Dropped or Withdrawn Student

Below are instructions on how to update or enter marks for students that have dropped a class or been withdrawn from school.


1. From Power Teacher click *PowerTeacher Pro* <https://powerschool.gpcsd.ca/teachers>
