Applications are now being accepted for the position of Strength & Conditioning Coach. The Strength and Conditioning Coach provides sport science support to the student-athletes of Celtic Academy through the creation of developmentally appropriate strength and conditioning programs. The role of the Strength & Conditioning Coach is to program for both St. Joseph and St. John Paul II/Faculté Jean-Paul II Catholic High School Celtic Academy Athletic Development Programs. The coach will also aid the teacher in teaching the fundamentals of training, and to assist in instilling confidence in the student-athletes. This will be done in accordance with the guidelines of the Long Term Athlete Development Model and CTS outcomes.

- Manage the fitness facilities.
- Maintain technical knowledge through a range of professional development activities.

The successful candidate will report to the Supervisor of the Celtic Academy and work cooperatively with school Principals.
